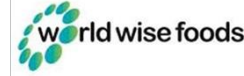


The FNET Journey

- The **Food Network for Ethical Trade (FNET)** is a supplier-led initiative born in 2016 from a desire to cascade ethical trade along global food supply chains, using the collective leverage of suppliers and retailers to bring about change
- We are currently **23 supplier members and 7 retailers**
- Our focus is on **suppliers' supply chains – Tier 2 and below**
- Our **mission** is to **improve human rights** in **global food supply chains** through a **common approach** to managing ethical trade

Workstream 1 – Risk Assessment

GOAL: Support members to rollout their risk assessment and identify best practice actions to take in response to risks identified

ACTIVITIES:

- Buddying scheme - 10 suppliers and 2 retailers providing 1 on 1 support developing and maintaining RAs
- Regular updates on emerging risks
- Working groups on supply chain mapping and mitigation guidance

OUTPUTS:

- **Up-to-date risk assessment tool**
- **Country-specific ethical trade risk assessments**
- **Supply chain mapping guidance document**
- **Mitigation common guidance document.**



Workstream 3 – Supplier Engagement

GOAL: Tackle the challenges of engaging suppliers' suppliers in ethical trade by collectively developing supplier engagement materials

ACTIVITIES

- Pilot ethical trade presentation and documents for training and engagement
- Pilot engagement materials for farmers
- Visual, simple language, easy for anyone to share with suppliers

OUTPUTS

- **Supplier Engagement presentation and background document**
- **Animated ethical trade materials (in development)**
- **Agent engagement events (in development)**

Phase 2 outcomes – May '18 - January '19

Supplier members are better able to deliver an **effective approach** to ethical trade due diligence

Supplier members are **more confident** operating in a pre-competitive space on ethical trade, collaborating and sharing information

Supplier members are **more connected** to, and/ or better informed about, existing ethical trade activities and initiatives

Retailer members have **greater confidence** in their suppliers' ability to deliver a robust ethical trade due diligence approach

Retailer members report that **greater alignment** has been possible
